With the aid of Norman's advanced security technologies like DNA Matching and Sandbox, Norman Endpoint Protection efficiently presents information about which computers have been infected and where any threats may be located. The clients listen and "sniff" for known and unknown security threats and automatically register when new units are connected to the network. What Patrik sees on the screen is a clear and easy to read bar that shows the level of threat in the network's computers from red via yellow to green. The information can be obtained

via e-mail or SMS if required, but in these early stages Patrik prefers to check it himself manually.

"Norman Endpoint Protection is very welcome and simplifies things for us tremendously," says Patrik.

"If we had to go round and change the protection in 130 shops all over Sweden, it would take four hours per shop on average, plus travelling time, so we are saving a lot of money."

An inbuilt policy tool is also included in Norman Endpoint Protection, which allows one to pre-install security levels for various parts of the network and quickly check the "health situation" of the network, something Patrik is also very happy with.

"We have gone from having quite limited control to having in principle full control over our entire business network. This is a big step for us and brings substantial benefits for the company," says Patrik. ●



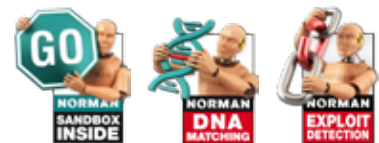
